PLEASE NOTE: The parade starts at Shannon Parkway and proceed east on 145th St., ending at Cameo Ave. ALL UNITS MUST ENTER FROM DIAMOND PATH AND 145th UNLESS SPECIFIED BY COMMITTEE.

Vendors wishing to sell items along the parade route must apply for a permit by July 1. The permit fee is \$100. For a Vendor Roaming Permit Application Form, please contact the Rosemount Parks and Recreation Department at 651-322-6010.

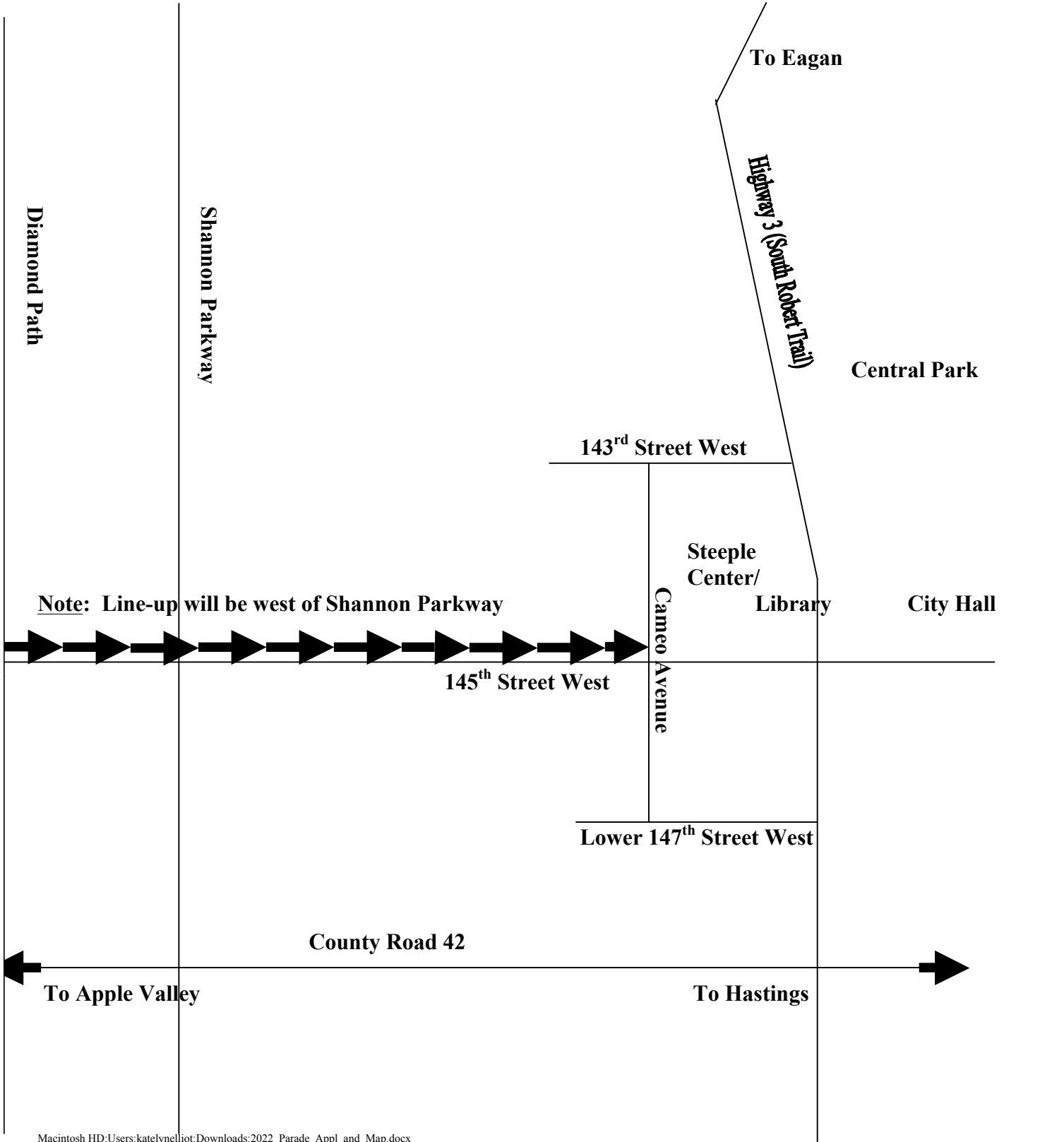
